COACHING ESSENTIALS

SCUK - How to Coach Children in Sport

Aimed at everyone working with children in sport, this workshop presents the basic principles of good practice.

SCUK - How to coach Disabled People in Sport

This workshop tackles all the frequently asked questions posed by sports teachers, coaches and participants about how to work with disabled sports people. The workshop will introduce and offer guidance to any coach involved with disabled people in sport. Coaches will be introduced to the inclusion spectrum and effective practice.

Protect yourself, the young people you are coaching and your employer by understanding and following good coaching practice. Learn about child abuse and how to handle situations if you have concerns.

In Safe Hands - Club Child Protection Officer Workshop

In Safe Hands focuses on helping clubs to put child protection policies into practice. The workshop is aimed at those acting in sport clubs as the Child Protection Officer. Subjects covered include legal duties, roles and responsibilities, practical procedures (including the safe recruitment and selection of those who have contact with children in sport) and how to appropriately manage concerns. Those attending *In Safe Hands* should have first attended Sport Coach UK's Safeguarding and Protecting Children workshop or equivalent.

Workshops are open to anyone aged 16 and over. If you have ten to twenty people who wish to attend the same Sports Coach UK workshop, it is possible to arrange a workshop at a separate date and time.
